## Paper Submission

Authors are invited to submit original and unpublished papers. All submissions will be peer-reviewed and judged on correctness, originality, significance and relevance to the special issue topics of interest. Abstract should be in about 300 words including 5-6 keywords. Full paper should be in MS Word, Times New Roman 12 point, with 1.5 line spacing fully justified. The front page of the paper should provide details of author's name, affiliation, organization, and email address and telephone number. All tables and figures should be numbered and should appear in the

corresponding text with captions. Source should be explicitly mentioned at the bottom of the table/figure. Kindly avoid using footnotes. All correspondence will be addressed to the first author only.

### **Proceeding and Publication Opportunities**

Following a double-blind peer review process, those Papers accepted for presentation will be published in the conference proceedings (with ISBN) subject to author registration and payment. Selected papers that have been presented at the conference will also be considered for publication in a number of high quality journals, including **International Review of Economics and Finance, Romanian Journal for Economic Forecasting, Defense and Peace Economics, Contemporary Economics**, etc.
